subjects. The humans stage

with their new weapons,
earn themselves a reprieve
from the shambling hordes.



Day 4, 6 p.m.
Humans receive news
of a potentially
operable homing
beacon that would
enable them to call for
rescue. Planning for
a mission to recover
and repair the beacon
begins immediately.
